

# The MBCBL looks for landmines at the movies!

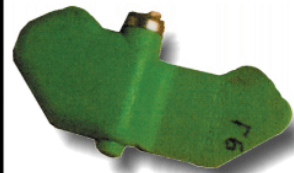
The Manitoba Campaign to Ban Landmines (MBCBL) is making a list of movies that include landmines as part of the plot. We need you to help us complete the list.
